MI FAMILIA

You will create a family tree in Spanish. This will be a project grade worth 100 points.
Remember that projects are worth 20% of your grade!

REQUIREMENTS:

1. You must include a family tree. The family tree should include vocabulary from chapter 6 (abuelos, padres, hermanos, primos, etc.) Each member should be listed by name and relationship to YOU.
2. You must include at least five pictures of family members (not one picture of five people). You may use the computer to scan pictures. If you do not have pictures of your family you may take pictures from a magazine (or the computer) which will “represent” your family. You must include yourself as a part of the family tree. The family tree must be completed on poster board size 22”x28”(or half that size but NOT smaller).
3. You will describe each picture with at least five Spanish sentences (typed). Be sure to identify the person in each picture. Use a variety of sentence structures, based on the vocabulary that you have learned. Here are some examples:

La muchacha es mi hermana.

Ella es muy bonita.

Mi abuelo tiene 80 años.

Mi prima lleva un vestido blanco.

Ella está en la sala de la casa.

Mi hermano es cómico.

Mi tío está en el jardín.

Mi primo Alejandro habla por teléfono.

Mi madre es alta y delgada.

Mis tíos son de San Francisco.

Tengo 13 años.

Soy morena(o) y simpática(o).

4. You will present your family tree. You need to memorize your lines and prepare an organized speech! You are allowed one index card for notes or bullet points but you may NOT read directly from your note card or your poster. Make sure to make eye contact with your audience!
